

KALAMAZOO SPEEDWAY FAST FACTS

fastest 3/8 mile oval in the world

- ✿ Opened in 1950 – 71 seasons of racing
- ✿ Located off US 131 – 10 minutes from Kalamazoo; 40 minutes south of Grand Rapids
- ✿ Paved 3/8 mile high-banked oval
- ✿ Paved pit space for 145 cars with trailers/haulers
- ✿ Seats 6,500 and includes 43 skyboxes (holding 8–16 guests each)
- ✿ Racing April through September
- ✿ Designated alcohol and smoke-free family seating (capacity of over 1,000)
- ✿ Paved accessible parking, modern restrooms and 30 acres of general parking
- ✿ Top of the line safety equipment staffed by paramedics
- ✿ Visiting series include the Winged and Non Winged Super Sprints, the Midwest Compact Touring Series, Open Wheel and Modified Series.
- ✿ Special events include the Red, White & Boom, Kalamazoo Klash, the legendary Night of Destruction, Super Shoe Nationals and Fireworks
- ✿ Six unique concession stands, two party decks (capacity of 240 and 100) plus hospitality services for groups up to 500
- ✿ Proud supporter of numerous local non-profit organizations, schools and churches
